

Fed-Track, Inc. Online Subscription Agreement

Terms and Conditions

DEFINITIONS

- A. The “Publisher” is Fed-Track, Inc.
- B. The “Publications” refer to any or all of the following online publications that are provided by the Publisher:
 - The Fed-Track Guide to Antidumping Findings and Orders
 - The Fed-Track Guide to Countervailing Duty Cases
 - The Fed-Track Guide to Investigations of Unfair Trade Practices
- C. The “Subscriber” is the entity that has agreed to these Terms and Conditions and has remitted the appropriate subscription fee to the Publisher. A Subscriber is confined to a single location.
- D. An “Authorized User” is an employee of the Subscriber doing work at the Subscriber’s site/location, or a contractor doing on-site work for the Subscriber.

Following are the terms and conditions governing rights and limitations for Internet access of online versions of the Publications:

These terms supersede any prior understanding between the Publisher and the Subscriber regarding user access to Publications.

Access to the Publications is granted for all Authorized Users on the following conditions:

- Subscriber’s acceptance of the Terms and Conditions described herein
- Receipt of the required subscription fee by the Publisher

In consideration of the payment of the appropriate subscription fee, the Subscriber and the Publisher agree to adhere to the following guidelines:

1. REPRODUCTION: All use of Publication content is subject to applicable Copyright law and reproduction of Publication content is allowed only as follows:
 - a. Downloading, printing, or saving of content for personal, non-commercial use is permissible. Systematic downloading is prohibited.
 - b. Commercial Redistribution: No commercial use (e.g. downloading, posting of a file, or printing to resell or distribute) of any content is permitted without prior, express written permission of the Publisher.

2. **UNAUTHORIZED ACCESS:** Subscriber agrees to the following:
 - a. Subscriber will undertake all necessary authentication and verification processes to ensure that only Authorized Users can access Publications
 - b. The Subscriber is responsible for creating and maintaining reasonable security measures, and enforcing policies consistent with the rights and restrictions described in these guidelines to ensure that only Authorized Users can access Subscriptions. The Subscriber is prohibited from making agreements for access to the Subscriptions with individuals, organizations, vendors, affiliates, or partners, which are not parts of the same organization purchasing this subscription.
 - c. If the Subscriber becomes aware of unauthorized access to Publications, it will notify Publisher immediately and cooperate in locating and attempting to stop the specific individuals who are abusing the service. If the specific abuser(s) cannot be identified or stopped, the Publisher has the right to withhold, suspend, or terminate access to all or any portion of the Publications, without liability.

3. **ACCESS DURATION:** The Publisher provides Publication access only for the term of this subscription and does not undertake to ensure future access to the online archives once the subscription term has expired.

4. **TECHNICAL ACCESS:** The Publisher intends for the site to be available 24-hours per day, 7 days per week. However, the Publisher will not be liable for damages or refunds should the site become unavailable temporarily or access to the site become slow or incomplete due to system back-up procedures, internet traffic volume, upgrades, overload of requests to the servers, general network failures or delays, or any other cause which may from time to time make the site inaccessible for the Subscriber's users.

5. **WARRANTY:** While the Publisher seeks to ensure the accuracy of content posted online, the Publisher does not warrant or guarantee its accuracy, completeness, merchantability, or fitness for a particular purpose. In no case shall the publisher liability for any content or accessibility problems with the site exceed the amount of subscription fees paid for the Subscription(s) during the 1-year period preceding any claim or notice of damages.
